



**FIREARMS ACT 1996**  
**Section 151(3)**  
**APPROVAL FOR THE OPERATION OF A RANGE**

I, Kerry Shepherd, a person having been appointed by the Commissioner of Police as his delegate (pursuant to Section 156 of the *Firearms Act 1996*) (the *Act*) in the exercise of the powers delegated to me, do hereby approve **Stephen Charles Evans Licence No 12002** (the holder'), being a representative of the **SSAA Huon Combined Shooting Club**. ('the club'), to operate a range situated at **Lethbridge Spur Road, Franklin, Tasmania** ('the range'). This approval is subject to the following conditions:

**Conditions of Approval**

- 1) The range is approved for:
  - Category A1 (Air rifles)
  - Category A2 (Rimfire other than self-loading)
  - Category A3 (shotgun other than pump action or self-loading)
  - Category B1 (Muzzle loading firearms)
  - Category B2 (Centrefire rifles other than self-loading)
  - Category C2 semi-auto shotguns provided the licence holder has been granted an exemption by the Commissioner of Police ('the Commissioner') to use Category C firearms for sport or target shooting.
  - Category H1 (Pistols)
  - Category H2 (Air Pistols)

**Conditions of approval**

- 1) No 6 - No 9 shot is only to be used in shotguns on the range.
- 2) Centrefire rifle calibres are not to exceed 8mm, however lever action rifles up to and including 45-70 Government may be used.
- 3) The Range may be used for, Competitive shooting, Instruction, Coaching, Training, junior development and sighting in of firearms applicable to any of the listed categories.
- 4) Danger notice signs and notice boards that comply with the Commissioner's *Range Specification Requirements for Shooting Ranges* ('the guidelines') are to be placed on the range boundary fence at suitable places/intervals where they may be seen by members of the public and be kept in good order.
- 5) A red flag is to be flown at the main gate when shooting is in progress on the range.
- 6) If night shooting is occurring a red flashing light is to be in operation.
- 7) All Range Officers are to exercise extreme care whilst shooting activities are taking place to prevent persons encroaching into the Range Danger Area.
- 8) The Club is to ensure that all club members and other organisations that might use the range are conversant with the conditions of this Range Approval.
- 9) The Range/Club Rules are to be displayed at the range/club facilities and a copy of the rules is to be made available to the Commissioner upon request.
- 10) Pursuant to Section 153(b) of the *Act*, the range and its equipment must not be altered without the consent of the Commissioner.
- 11) Should any change or modification be made to the construction of the range with the Commissioner's consent, the holder is to confirm the Commissioner of such change or modification in writing within 14 days.
- 12) This approval is valid until **16 May 2023** unless cancelled or withdrawn before that date.
